



## A GOLDEN GATE GOLF EXPERIENCE WITH JORDAN CARON

A visit to one of Jordan's favourite cities, combining golf with the amazing Napa Valley Wine Train

Jordan will show you some of the best courses in and around the Bay Area, from the site of the 2009 President's Cup matches at Harding Park, to the bluffs of the Pacific Ocean at the Ocean Course at Half Moon Bay resort. Known for its steep rolling hills, Monterey Cypress trees, Victorian Architecture and ethnic downtown core, San Francisco is a wonderful city with much to do off of the golf course. *"On top of magic golf, the unique and vintage Napa Valley Wine Train will surely be a memorable way to see the Napa Valley."*

Arriving into San Francisco we will transfer to the exquisite **Fairmont San Francisco** located in the centre of downtown and only a short cable car ride to many of the city's most beautiful districts.

The first round of golf will be at **Harding Park**, with towering Monterey Cypress trees and great vistas, and host to the 2009 Presidents Cup. You'll also get a chance to play at **Monarch Bay** and the **Ocean course at Half Moon Bay**, both providing outstanding views of ocean and skyline. A new gem on our itinerary will be the work of the latest architect superstar David McKay Kidd, designer of Bandon Dunes, who has built a wonderful Cliffside links course called the **TPC at Stonebrae**. A real treat!

The highlight of your tour might be the Napa Valley Wine Train, a 4 hour wine and dine experience to cap off your tour!

### Friday April 23rd 2010

Arrive San Francisco and transfer to the world renowned Fairmont San Francisco. Enjoy a welcome dinner at the tropical and festive Tonga Room and Hurricane Bar, a fun spot that signifies what our Experiences are all about!

### Saturday April 24th

What a way to start the first day of your Golf Experience as you play the host course of the 2009 Presidents Cup, Harding Park. Set amongst the towering Monterey Cypress trees and the banks of beautiful Lake Merced the course was recently renovated to host a World Golf Championship event in 2005. Can you believe this was John Daly's last big performance? He lost to Tiger Woods in a playoff.

### Sunday April 25th

Following up Harding Park will be our second round of golf at the Monarch Bay Golf Course. Located on the eastern side of the Bay of San Francisco the course recently spent 9 million dollars on renovations and looks back towards the amazing city skyline of San Francisco.

### Monday April 26th

With no golf scheduled for today, it's a free day to experience the Wine Train! The day starts with a beautiful 90 minute ferry ride to Vallejo where a shuttle takes you the short distance to Napa. A wine tasting in the station itself, and then we'll take you on board one of the most unique restaurants in the world, the Napa Valley Wine Train, which takes you on a two hour gourmet dining journey through the Napa Valley. Then a 2 hour private tour of two great vineyards and back to the ferry in time for arrival back to the Fairmont at 7:00pm. Wine tastings included, but lunch wine is at your expense.

### Tuesday April 27th

Back to golf and a new facility that just opened in 2008 and is located in the hills of the east San Francisco bay. The TPC at Stonebrae is a work of popular Scottish Architect David McKay Kidd who also designed Bandon Dunes and the newest course in St. Andrews, The Castle Course. Kidd's Scottish roots are evident at Stonebrae as the course provides an enjoyable links experience for golfers of all skill levels.

### Wednesday April 28th

Another Free day to enjoy the sights and sounds of San Francisco. You cannot go to San Fran. without visiting Fisherman's Wharf, San Francisco's most popular destination. Known for its historic waterfront, delicious seafood, spectacular sights and unique shopping, Fisherman's Wharf offers a wide array of things to do for everyone.
