THE CLASSIC CLUB PALM SPRINGS, CALIFORNIA

This nationally recognized championship course designed by Arnold Palmer and a host site of the Bob Hope Chrysler Classic, creates a new spin on desert golf with rolling terrain, wide landing areas, 30 acres of water features, 14 bridges as well as an abundance of pine trees and pine straw ground cover with 5 sets of tees on each hole.

It is unlikely any desert course features quite as much water in such abundance as the Classic club. And for those right handers who are prone to slice, most of the water is on the right hand side of at least 14 fairways! It is also advisable to practice your bunker shots, both greenside and fairway, as the course has over 150 traps in play.

The Classic Club 18th hole was selected as one of the three Most Beautifully Brutal Par 5 Golf Holes in the Southwest United States.

This is a long course and without significant elevation changes it is tricky to see your target clearly. Although fore-caddies are included with each group, we recommend you take a personal caddy to increase your enjoyment of this PGA Tour stop. It is a rare luxury to find a Caddy program these days in North America, and all golfers can benefit from this Professional touch.
